

**SHEVIOCK PARISH COUNCIL**

**Notes from the meeting at Portwrinkle to discuss the Site for the New Bus Shelter.  
Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> January 2016 at 11.30pm.**

Present: Cllrs C Kennedy, P McLaren and Mrs D Mathias

In Attendance: Mrs L Coles, Parish Clerk, and Bryan Pullinger, Chairman of the Rame Peninsular Transport User Group.

There were 25 members of the public present.

Bryan Pullinger, Chair of the RPTUG, opened the meeting and thanked all those in attendance for coming. He gave an overview of the detail behind the decision for installing a bus shelter and thanked Cllr Kennedy and the Parish Council for its persistence in securing authorisation for the bus stop in Portwrinkle, which was finally achieved last April. Possible sites were discussed as well as the traffic restrictions which would be caused by the bus parking at the bus shelter. One of the original options was the site at the far end of the car park, adjacent to Mr Waterfield's residence but this is not suitable because the bus would effectively have to reverse blind onto the road.

Bryan Pullinger handed the meeting over to Cllr Kennedy.

Cllr Kennedy said that the Parish Council has suggested using the site around the existing bench, opposite the bus stop, on the promenade (Site 1). The entrance to the shelter would be on the road side and it would have a glass face towards the sea. Cllr Kennedy showed a picture of the proposed bus shelter. Foundations will be needed.

Paul Phillips suggested siting the bus shelter next to the ticket machine, where the section of the car park is hatched, which would negate the need to walk between parked vehicles from the shelter to the bus stop. However, this section also has a dropped kerb which is necessary for disabled access and so it was suggested that the shelter is put onto part of the grassed flower bed next to the ticket machine instead (Site 2). Another suggestion was that the shelter was put around the bench at the far end of the car park (Site 3).

Cllr Kennedy asked for a vote on each of these sites as follows:

Site 1 – opposite bus stop and Whitsand Bay View – 11 Votes for.

**Site 2 – on the grassed flowerbed near the ticket machine – 14 Votes for.**

Site 3 – around the bench at the far end of the car park – 11 Votes for.

Site 2 is the preferred option.
